INTERACTIVE ART

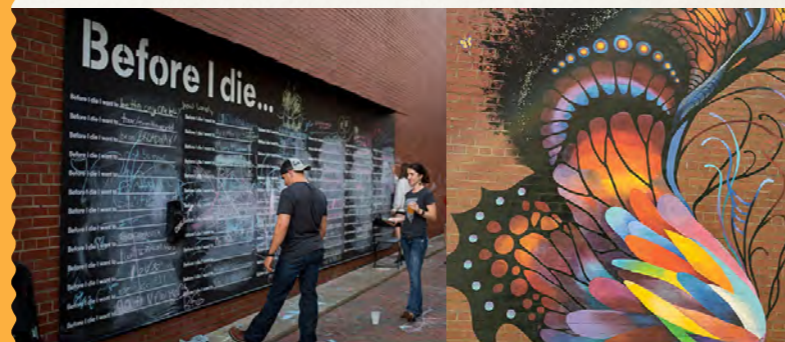
For enduring memories, connect and engage with art pieces you can physically interact with and become a part of.

MURALS

Soak up Sanford's rich and fascinating history through outdoor murals and feel a sense of pride and belonging.



M1: 'OFF TO WAR' WORLD WAR II MEMORIAL

Honors the service men and women of Sanford and Lee County both past and present. *Muralist: Chris Dalton*

M2: STEVE JONES

Honors hometown football Hall of Famer Steve Jones who played for the Buffalo Bills and the St. Louis Cardinals. *Muralist: Chris Dalton*

M3: HERB THOMAS AND THE FABULOUS HUDSON HORNET

Honors Hall of Famer and one of NASCAR's greatest drivers Herb Thomas and his famous race car. *Muralist: Scott Nurkin*

M4: PIEDMONT BLUES

Depicts Floyd Council and Pink Anderson, two great blues musicians with strong ties to Sanford. *Muralist: Britt Flood*

M5: CATERPILLAR & WINGS

Depicts a whimsical 3-D caterpillar and a beautiful set of butterfly wings perfect for pictures. *Muralist: Chris Dalton*

M6: FAIRVIEW DAIRY

Celebrates the history of Fairview Dairy, which provided milk for the city of Sanford in the early 1900s. *Muralist: Chris Dalton*

M7: SILENT WINGS

Honors WWII glider pilots Lee Roy Perry, Frank Blalock Sr., and Edward "Bucky" Williams. *Muralist: Scott Nurkin*

M8: VISIONARY BUILDERS

Honors prolific builder and business owner Link Boykin and beloved educator W.B. Wicker. *Muralist: Scott Nurkin*

M9: SANFORD SPINNERS

Honors athletes who played for the Sanford Spinners in the Tobacco State League during the late 1940s. *Muralist: Scott Nurkin*

M10: BRINGING THE ARTS TOGETHER

Celebrates over 50 years of art in Sanford and depicts a spinning wheel highlighting a vibrant mix of art forms. *Muralist: Chris Dalton*

M11: DR. MARY MARGARET MCLEOD

Honors the beloved physician who started Sanford's first pediatric practice. *Muralist: Chris Dalton*

M12: J.D. MCDUFFIE

Honors a bona fide NASCAR legend with 653 cup starts and 106 top-10 finishes during his career. *Muralist: Chris Dalton*

M13: TOBACCO MURAL

Celebrates Sanford's rich agricultural past, present and future. *Muralist: Chris Dalton*

M14: DREAM

Sparks the collective imagination with a depiction of flying pigs gliding over a pastoral landscape. *Muralist: Chris Dalton*

M15: JONESBORO CORNET BAND

Honors historic Jonesboro's popular music group formed when Sanford and Jonesboro were separate cities. *Muralist: Scott Nurkin*
